EXTENDED DAYS FOR OCTOBER

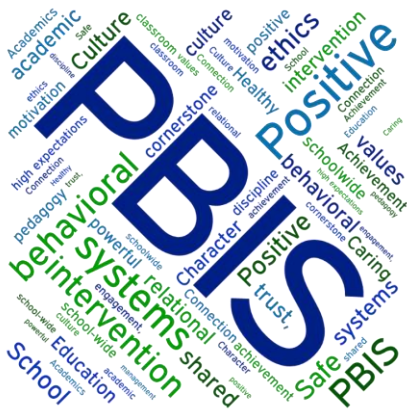
The Division of Communications and Community Relations is providing translated versions of the notification letter for families regarding the extended school days due to Hurricane Irma.

Parents as you know our school is now participating in the PBIS program. The term PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Intervention Supports. PBIS is a research based program that recognizes students for positive behaviors in school. In addition to recognizing students for positive behavior in the classroom, our program will also extend itself to the cafeteria, restroom, playground, and hallways.

Parents who choose to walk children into school - please understand that this is the reason we continue to ask you to use Miss Penny's crosswalk.

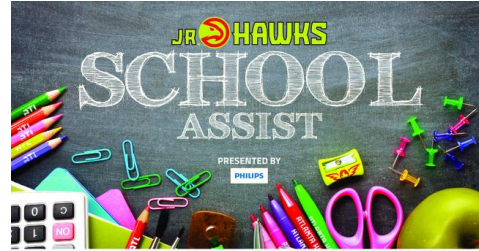

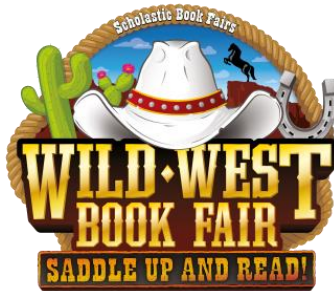
