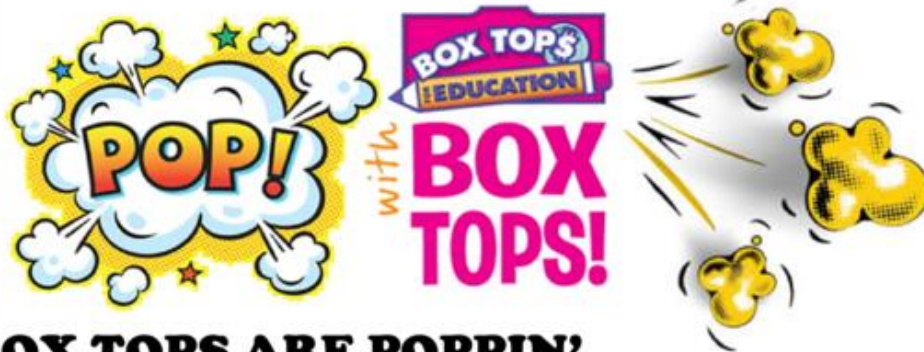

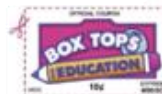
How to Submit Box Tops:

The class or staff member that brings in the most Box Tops (including bonus app) the staff member will receive a \$20 Visa Gift Card!



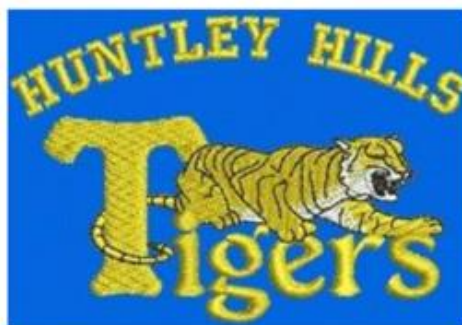
