

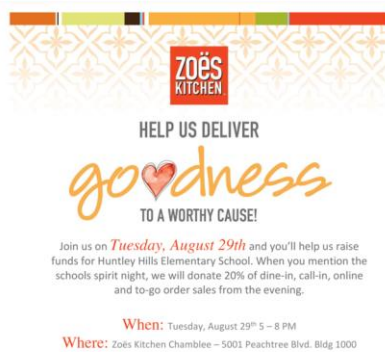

MAP TESTING/GIFTED ELIGIBILITY

MAP testing continues this week! Please look at the schedule below for your child's testing days and make sure your child gets a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast to help them perform their best.

The DeKalb County School District (DCSD) utilizes the Northwest Evaluation Association Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) as the initial assessment towards gifted identification each school year for students in grades K-10. Students who score $\geq 90\%$ RT (Reading Total) or $\geq 90\%$ MT (Math Total) on the nationally norm-referenced assessment (MAP) will take additional gifted formal evaluations. Although the MAP assessment is administered three times per year, the gifted eligibility window is August–September for currently enrolled K-10 students and December–February for currently enrolled K-2 and new students.



Walk/Bike to School Day Wednesday, August 30th



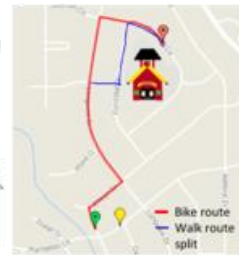
We will start at the Huntley Hills Pool Parking Lot at 2040 Plantation Ln., leaving promptly at 7:15am it's a 12 minute walk.
